


Search Using the Wildcard *

A wildcard is a character that you can enter in place of criteria of which you are uncertain. In Matrix the wildcard is an asterisk “*”.

Wildcard Facts

The Wildcard...

- is an asterisk *
- can only be used in Free-type fields
- cannot be used in the Speed Bar

- Type the known criteria in the selected field, then type the asterisk *  in place of the criteria in question.

Example 1: You can't remember if the street name is “Oak Leaf” or “Oak Tree.”

- Your search results contain the known criteria (in Example1 Street Name begins with “Oak”) plus results with anything that comes after the known criteria.

Example 2: You want to find listing where Public Remarks mention “renovation” or “renovated.”

Search Using the Wildcard *

- Place the asterisk before and after ³ the known criteria. In our example the known criterion is “renovat” which are the first 7 letters in both words.

Note: The placement and exclusion of spaces is important. In our example, the first asterisk is followed by a space, but the second asterisk was added without a space after “renovat” as that is not a full word.

- Your search results contain the known criterion plus anything before and after. (In Example 2 the results contain the listings with Public Remarks that contain the character string “renovat” and anything before and after that known criterion.)
