

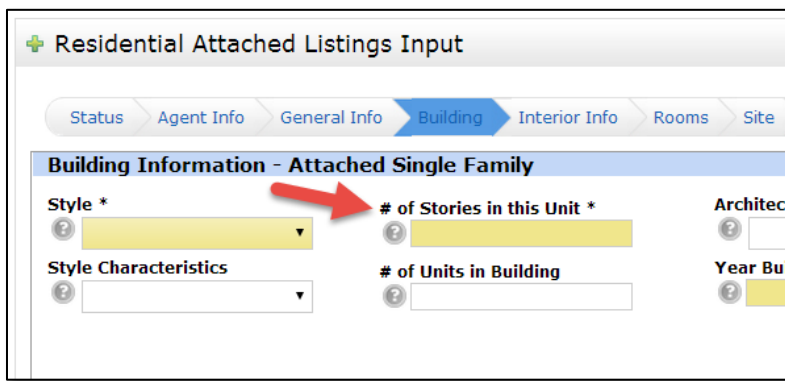


Based on customer feedback, important updates are being made on February 19, 2014 to listing input for Attached Single Family listings.

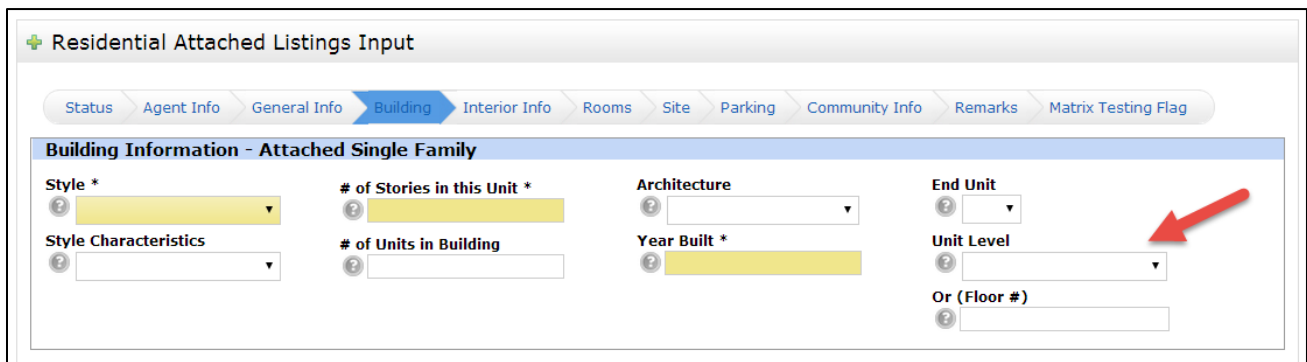
- You told us it is important to be able to search for an Attached Single Family unit that is 1, 2, or more stories.
- The field **# of Stories in this Unit** will now be required on all Attached Single Family listings so you'll be able to search by and see this important information.

**Listing Input - Residential Attached Single Family:**

- On the Building tab, the field **# of Floors in Unit** has been renamed to **# of Stories in this Unit**. You should use this field to indicate if your listing is 1 story (ranch), 2 story, or another number of stories or levels.



- **# of Stories in this Unit** will be required on all Attached Single Family listings.
- This field is not used to indicate the floor number that the unit is on within the building. To indicate the floor number the unit is on, select the **Unit Level** (Garden, Ground, or Penthouse) or enter the **Floor #**.



- You'll be required to complete **# of Stories in this Unit** even for previously-entered listings. For example, if you are making a status change to an Attached Single Family listing and this field is not completed, you will need to update **# of Stories in this Unit** before you can save the status change.
- On the Interior Info tab, you can now enter SqFt into any of the SqFt fields (including SqFt Basement) for all Attached Single Family styles (Condominium, Townhouse, and Other Multi-Unit).

Searching:

- On the Residential General Search, **# of Stories in Unit** has been added to the main search template. Use this field to search for Attached Single Family listings that are 1, 2, or another number of stories or levels.
- On the Cross Property General Search, **# of Stories in Unit** has been added to the main search template.
- **Note:** On either search, you should not combine **# of Stories in Unit** with Styles that are only available on Detached Single Family, such as 2 Story or Ranch/1 Story. Doing so will return 0 search results.
